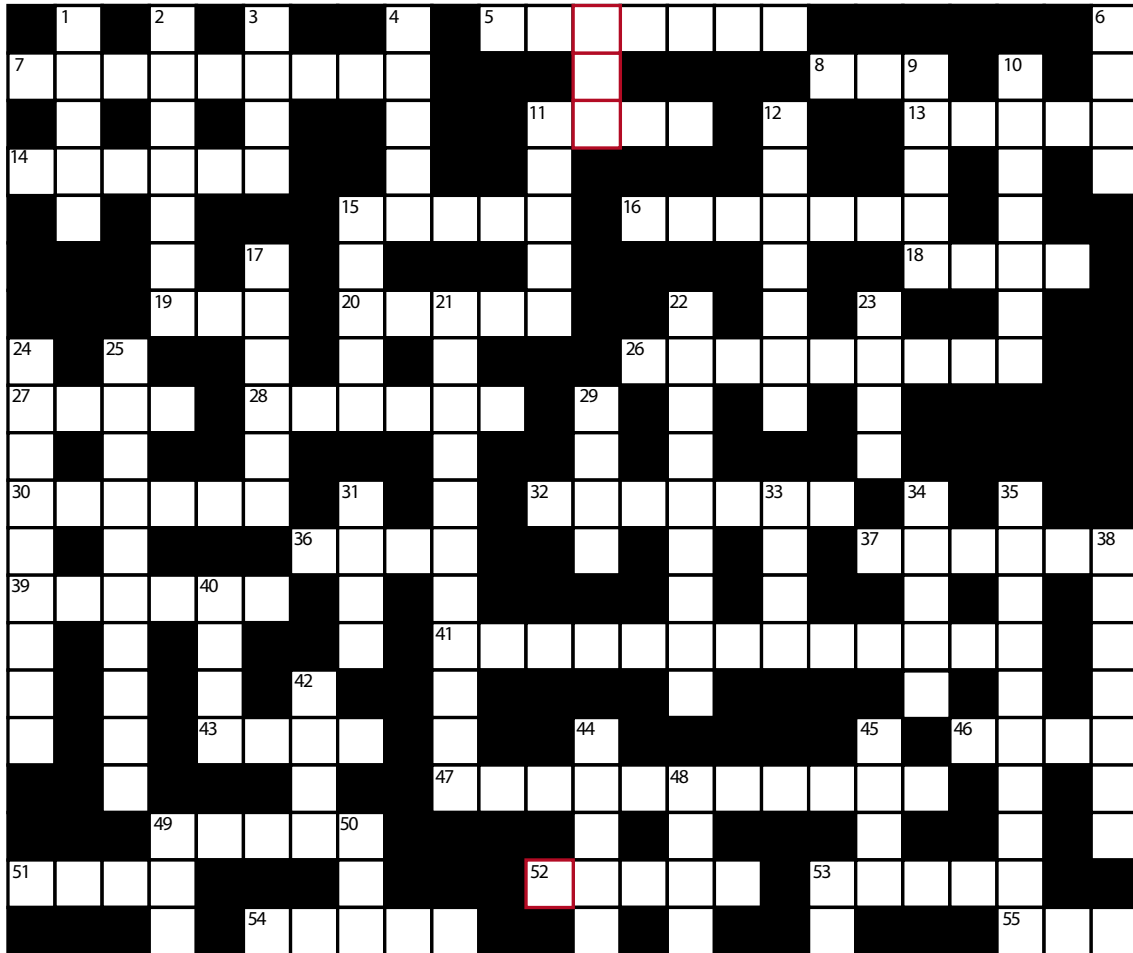


# ESKIMO JOE'S TRIVIA CROSSWORD
